The Binding of Isaac (Genesis 22)

Big Question: What does a life of faith look like?

Here I Am to Impossible Challenges

- *Genesis 22:1* – After these things God tested Abraham and said to him, “Abraham!” And he said, “Here I am.”
- A life of faith says “Here I am” to impossible challenges.

Here I Am to Unimaginable Hope

- *Genesis 22:2* – He said, “Take your son, your only son Isaac, whom you love, and go to the land of Moriah, and offer him there as a burnt offering ...”
- *Genesis 22:4–5* – Then Abraham said to his young men, “Stay here with the donkey; I and the boy will go over there and worship and [we will] come again to you.”
- *Genesis 22:7* – And Isaac said to his father Abraham, “My father!” And he said, “Here I am, my son.” He said, “... where is the lamb for a burnt offering?”
- *Genesis 22:8* – Abraham said, “God will provide for himself the lamb”
- *Hebrews 11:17–19* – By faith Abraham, when he was tested, offered up Isaac ... He considered that God was able even to raise him from the dead
- A life of faith says “Here I am” to unimaginable hope.

Here I Am to the Goodness of God

- *Genesis 22:9–10* – Then Abraham reached out his hand and took the knife to slaughter his son.
- *Genesis 22:11* – But the angel of the Lord called to him from heaven and said, “Abraham, Abraham!” And he said, “Here I am.”
- A life of faith says “Here I am” to the goodness of God.

Great Is Thy Faithfulness

- *Genesis 22:12–14* – He said, “Do not lay your hand on the boy or do anything to him...” And Abraham lifted up his eyes and looked, and behold, behind him was a ram, caught in a thicket by his horns. ... So Abraham called the name of that place, “The Lord will provide”; as it is said to this day, “On the mount of the Lord it shall be provided.”
- A life of faith knows God deserves your son but would never require it of you.
- *2 Chronicles 3:1* – “Then Solomon began to build the house of the Lord in Jerusalem on Mount Moriah ...”
- *John 3:16* – “For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son ...”
- Abraham’s faith is great. God’s faithfulness is greater.
